

Exhibitor Covid 19 Secure Requirements

As stated on the previous page the event has been redesigned as an open market style event to cater for Social Distancing

In our meeting with various Safety Advisory Groups the key element of their requirements has always been social distancing as it is the primary source of spread and the hardest to enforce.

So we are looking for solid support from all our exhibitors and would ask you to observe the following guidelines laid down by both the Government and the local district Council.

Masks or Visors

Currently we are working with 2m social distancing or 1m plus, the plus being masks, visors or screens.

The visitors in the main will chose not to wear masks which leaves the onus on Living Heritage staff and you the Exhibitor. For ease of consistency all exhibitors and staff should wear a visor to enable closer liaison and ease with your customers. If you decide to allow customers to enter your marquee (size permitting) masks/ visors will be mandatory unless medically exempt. We would also look to you to organise and monitor social distancing within your marquee, possibly this would involve a one-way system. Social distancing includes up to six people in a social bubble.

Track and Trace

We will require contact details of all your personnel on your stand employed during the event.

Setting up your stand

Regardless of whether you are using a Living Heritage shedding unit or your own marquee on ground space, the front line of your marquee is the front line. No displays or goods are permitted in the front of this line to avoid abuse of social distancing.

Exhibitors with larger stands should also allow for social distancing with a one way system. There will be extra sanitiser stations around the event, and we recommend visitors to bring their own, but would also suggest you provide your own on your stand, it's a professionally inviting image and gives confidence.

Exhibitor Health

Another important area of concern is transmission of the virus by infected persons. If you or a member of your family, member of staff and their family, display any of the symptoms of Covid 19 – high temperature, new persistent cough, loss of taste & smell please take medical advise prior to attending the event.

Other Covid 19 Event Features

1. The event has been extended to four days with a fixed number of daily tickets.
2. Track and Trace for Exhibitors and Visitors
3. Enhanced cleaning and hygiene

Other important features include toilets. There will be 2 main toilet locations, each consisting of 2 sets of toilets, enabling one set to be cleaned whilst the other set is open.

For Exhibitors staying on site overnight there will be a special elsan tank for emptying caravan waste. Do not attempt to empty into the show toilets please.

Tables and general surfaces will again be cleaned regularly either manually, spraying or by fogging machines.

4. Hand Sanitisers – we would ask you to bring your own sanitisers to the show. There will be sanitiser stations at locations all around the event, entrances, exits, toilets, food courts, children's rides and amusements and general walkways around the event.
5. Enhanced First Aid. Our normal First Aid is available, together with a specialist Covid Team and quarantine facilities.

With the changeable nature of Covid 19 advice the above may be changed if advice at the time of the event is altered. Please view the website prior to travelling.
