

19. Removal and Disposal of Disposable Gloves

Pinch and hold the outside of the glove near the wrist area. Peel downwards, away from the wrist, turning the glove inside out. Pull the glove away until it is removed from the hand and hold the inside-out glove with the gloved hand. Then repeat ensuring loose glove is contained within the second glove. Dispose gloves into waste bin straight away.
